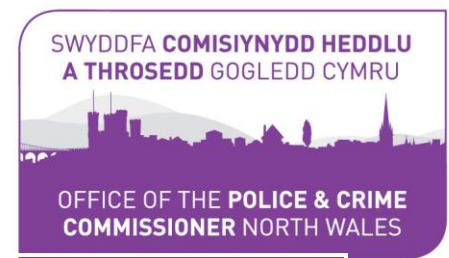


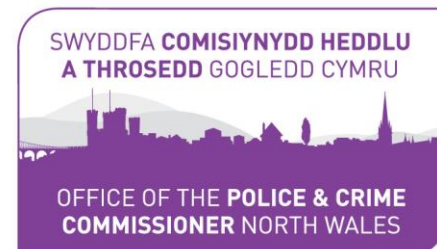

Crynodeb Gweithredol:	Executive Summary:
<p>Mae Glasbrint ar gyfer Troseddwy'r Benywaidd ar y cyd y Weinyddiaeth Gyfiawnder a Llywodraeth Cymru (2019), yn rhoi cyfle i gyflymu diwygio a thrawsnewid gwasanaethau i ferched yn y System Cyfiawnder Troseddol (gan ddysgu'r gwersi o'r Cynllun Braenaru Merched). Canolbwytir ar greu datrysiadau cymunedol cynaliadwy er mwyn cadw merched a chymunedau'n ddiogel ac yn rhydd o drosedd, yn dilyn ymdriniaeth ar sail y dystiolaeth.</p> <p>Mae'r Glasbrint yn cael ei gyflwyno drwy chwe ffrwd waith unigol, a arweinir gan arweinwyr amlasiantaethau ac amlddisgyblaethol, gan ddarparu ymdriniaeth ledled Cymru. Mae'r chwe ffrwd waith unigol yn cynnwys:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ymyrraeth ac Ataliaeth Gynnar • Llysoedd a Dedfrydu • Dalfa ac Ailsefydlu • Ymchwil a Gwerthuso (ffrwd waith ar y cyd gyda phrosiect Glasbrint ar gyfer Cyfiawnder Ieuenctid), a • Systemau a Llywodraethu (ffrwd waith ar y cyd gyda phrosiect Glasbrint ar gyfer Cyfiawnder Ieuenctid). <p>Ers dechrau'r prosiect, mae tîm cyflawni'r Glasbrint ar gyfer Troseddwy'r Benywaidd wedi ceisio nodi cyfleoedd i symleiddio ffrydiau gwaith (gan gynnwys cyfuno ffrydiau gwaith gyda ffrydiau gwaith Glasbrint ar gyfer Cyfiawnder Ieuenctid) a bod yn ddyfeisgar lle bynnag mae'n bosibl. Gwneir hyn i leihau galw ar arweinwyr unigol ac ar bartneriaid ehangach. Fodd bynnag, mae arweinwyr ffrydiau gwaith wedi ymroi i gyflawni'r rhaglen waith uchelgeisiol hon ar ben eu swyddi dyddiol presennol. Mae adborth gan arweinwyr ffrydiau gwaith wedi amlygu angen am adnodd prosiect ychwanegol i roi cymorth ffrwd gwaith a chynorthwyo ffrydiau gwaith wrth fwrw ymlaen gydag ymchwil a gwerthuso a nodwyd, gan alluogi ymdriniaeth dan arweiniad tystiolaeth i gyflawniad.</p> <p>Cyflwynwyd achos busnes am adnodd ychwanegol gan y Prif Berchennog Cyfrifol Glasbrint ar gyfer Troseddwy'r Benywaidd (Emma Wools) ac fe'i cytunwyd mewn egwyddor gan Fwrdd y Rhaglen Glasbrint ym mis Chwefror 2020. Mae'r Achos Busnes yn amlinellu cynnig am fuddsoddiad a rennir gan bartneriaid gan gynnwys Llywodraeth Cymru, GCPHEM a Chomisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd ar gyfer adnodd ychwanegol i gynorthwyo'r prosiect Glasbrint. Gofynnwyd i CHTh gyfrannu oddeutu £30,000 ar y cyd, fel rhan o'r buddsoddiad partneriaeth. Roedd hyn er mwyn</p>	<p>The joint Ministry of Justice and Welsh Government Female Offending Blueprint (2019), provides an opportunity to accelerate the reform and transformation of services for women in the Criminal Justice System (drawing on the lessons learned from the Women's Pathfinder) through a focus on creating sustainable community-based solutions to keeping women and communities safe and free from crime, based on an evidence-led approach.</p> <p>The Blueprint is being delivered via six individual workstreams, led by multi-agency, multi-disciplinary leads, providing a pan-Wales approach. The six individual workstreams include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Early Intervention and Prevention • Courts and Sentencing • Custody and Resettlement • Community Sentences • Research and Evaluation (joint workstream with Youth Justice Blueprint project), and • Systems and Governance (joint workstream with Youth Justice Blueprint project). <p>Since the commencement of the project, the Female Offending Blueprint delivery team has sought to identify opportunities to streamline workstreams (including merging workstreams with Youth Justice Blueprint workstreams) and resource wherever possible, to minimise demand both on individual leads and on wider partners. However, workstream leads have committed to delivering this ambitious programme of work on top of their existing day jobs and feedback from workstream leads has highlighted a need for additional project resource to provide workstream support and to support workstreams in taking forward identified research and evaluation activity, enabling an evidence-led approach to delivery.</p> <p>A business case for additional resource was submitted by the Female Offending Blueprint Project SRO (Emma Wools) and agreed in principle by the Blueprint Programme Board in February 2020. The Business Case sets out a proposal for a shared investment by partners including Welsh Government, HMPPS and Police and Crime Commissioners for additional resource to support the Blueprint project. PCCs were asked to collectively contribute, as part of the partnership investment, approximately £30,000 in order to secure resource including a Project Officer and Research Officer (shared across Female Offending and Youth Justice Blueprint) to enable</p>

A copy of the Resources Business Case is attached for reference.</p> <p>The Project seeks agreement for a £30,000 investment into project support and research officer resource for the Female Offending Blueprint project (as articulated in the attached Business Case) to be shared across the four Police and Crime Commissioners, with funding contribution broken down as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Office of the South Wales Police and Crime Commissioner – £15,000 o Office of the North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner – £5,000 o Office of the Dyfed-Powys Police and Crime Commissioner – £5,000 o Office of the Gwent Police and Crime Commissioner – £5,000 <p>South Wales OPCC have agreed to act as 'banker' for this funding.</p>
