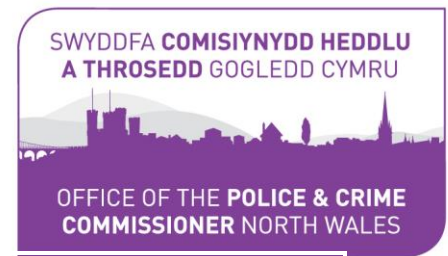

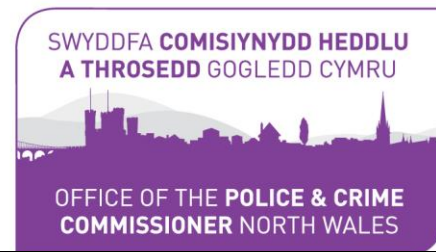



Crynodeb Gweithredol:	Executive Summary:
<p>Mae'r Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd wedi rhoi cyfraniad o £60,037.25 i DASU North Wales Ltd i gyflwyno Gwasanaeth Cyngtori Annibynnol Rhanbarthol Cam-drin Domestig (IDVA) ledled siroedd Conwy, Dinbych, Y Fflint a Wrecsam.</p> <p>Mae'r Gwasanaethau hyn yn gweithio i ymdrin â diogelwch pawb sydd mewn perygl mawr o drais a cham-drin domestig gan bartneriaid clos, cyn bartneriaid ac aelodau o'r teulu er mwyn sicrhau eu diogelwch a diogelwch eu plant. Gan weithredu fel prif bwynt cyswllt, mae gwasanaethau IDVA fel arfer yn gweithio gyda'u cleientiaid o bwynt argyfwng er mwyn asesu'r risg, edrych ar opsiynau, a datblygu a gweithredu cynlluniau er mwyn ymdrin a'u diogelwch ar unwaith, ynghyd â datrysiadau tymor hirach. Bydd y cynlluniau hyn yn cynnwys gweithrediadau o'r Gynhadledd Asesu Risg Amlasiantaethau (MARAC) ynghyd â sancsiynau a datrysiadau ar gael drwy'r llysoedd troseddol a sifil, opsiynau tai a gwasanaethau sydd ar gael drwy sefydliadau eraill. Er na fydd y gwasanaeth yn gweithio'n uniongyrchol â phlant o dan 16 oed, bydd yn gwneud atgyfeiriadau er mwyn diogelu plant sydd mewn perygl o niwed a sicrhau cyfeirio priodol at wasanaethau cymorth arbenigol. Bydd y gwasanaeth ar gael i bob cleient y mae cam-drin domestig yn effeithio arnynt, waeth beth fo'u rhyw, rhywioldeb, ethnigrwydd neu anabledd. Bydd y gwasanaeth yn cael ei ddarparu drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg fel y bo'n briodol.</p> <p>Bydd DASU North Wales Ltd yn gweithio mewn partneriaeth agos gyda gwasanaethau perthnasol eraill er mwyn cyflwyno cyflawniad cyffredinol er mwyn siapio cyfeiriad ymdrin â VAWDASV yng Ngogledd Cymru yn y dyfodol.</p>	<p>The Police and Crime Commissioner has provided a contribution of £60,037.25 to DASU North Wales Ltd to deliver Regional Independent Domestic Violence Advisory (IDVA) Service across Conwy, Denbighshire, Flintshire and Wrexham.</p> <p>IDVAs work to address the safety of all people at high risk of domestic violence and abuse from intimate partners, ex-partners and family members to secure their safety and the safety of their children. Operating as the primary point of contact, IDVAs typically work with their clients from the point of crisis to assess the risk, review options, and develop and implement plans to address their immediate safety, as well as longer-term solutions. These plans will include actions from the Multi Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC) as well as sanctions and remedies available through the criminal and civil courts, housing options and services available through other organisations. Although the service will not work directly with children under the age of 16, it will make referrals to safeguard children at risk of harm and ensure appropriate signposting to specialist support services. The service will be available for all clients affected by domestic abuse, regardless of gender, sexuality, ethnicity or disability. The service will be provided through the medium of Welsh as appropriate.</p> <p>DASU North Wales Ltd will work in close partnership with other relevant services to support overall delivery in order to shape the future direction of addressing VAWDASV in North Wales.</p>
