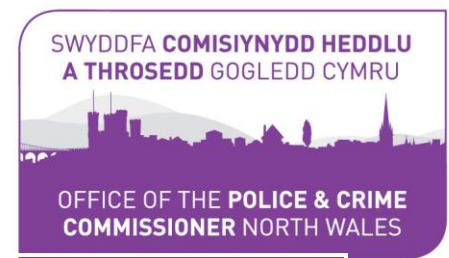

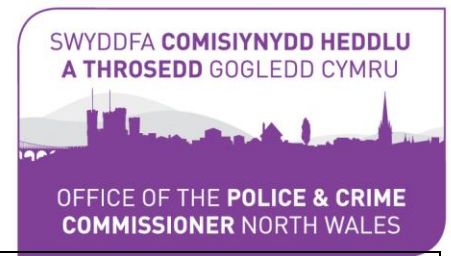

<p>Mae’r Cynllun Braenaru Merched yn gynllun dargyfeirio a gomisiynwyd i gynorthwyo troseddwr benywaidd i osgoi trafferth gyda’r gyfraith a llywio merched i ffwrdd o drosedd drwy ddarparu u cyfleoedd i ddiwygio ac ailsefydlu.</p> <p>Gwnaiff prosiect y Cynllun Braenaru Merched ddarparu ymyriadau i ferched sydd wedi cael dargyfeirio drwy’r gwasanaeth Checkpoint mewn Dalfeydd yn hytrach na chael eu cyhuddo o drosedd lefel is. Mae’r gwasanaeth hefyd yn derbyn merched sydd mewn perygl o fynd i’r system Cyfiawnder Troseddol a gall merched gael eu cyfeirio drwy asiantaethau neu hunan - atgyweirio yn yr amgylchiadau hyn.</p>	<p>The Women’s Pathfinder is a diversion scheme commissioned to help and support women reduce reoffending. By understanding the underlying causes of their offending behaviours, pathfinder will steer women away from crime by providing opportunities to reform and rehabilitate.</p> <p>The Women’s Pathfinder project will provide interventions to women who have been diverted via the Custody based Checkpoint service as an alternative to being charged for low level offence. The service also accepts women who are at risk of entering the Criminal Justice system and women can be referred through agencies or self-refer in some circumstances.</p>

Monitrir y gwaith hwn drwy adolygiad cytundeb chwarterol lle mae diweddariadau cyflawniad yn cael eu rhoi ger bron y bwrdd.</p>	<p>Financial: £178,249.50 has been made available from Crime and Disorder Grant 20/21 provided by the Police and Crime Commissioner to support this innovative work.</p> <p>Legal: The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 enables the Commissioner to award grants to partners, public organisations or voluntary groups that can support the community safety priorities identified in the Police and Crime Plan.</p> <p>Police and Crime Plan: This area of work will help the Commissioner meet his main statutory duty of delivering an effective and efficient policing service in North Wales. This work will be monitored through the Safer Communities Board where performance updates will be tabled.</p>
