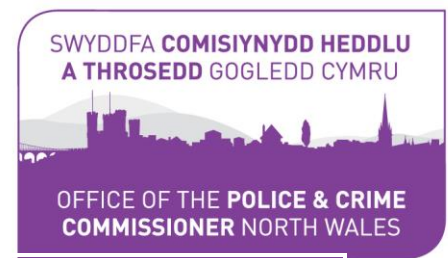

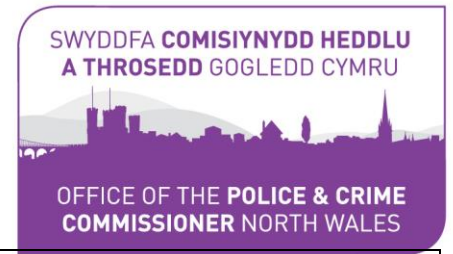

Crynodeb Gweithredol:	Executive Summary:
<p>Cynllun gwirfoddol sy'n dargyfeirio oedolion sy'n troseddau yw CheckPoint, sydd ar waith ar hyn o bryd yn ardal Cwnstablfaeth Durham. Mae'n targedu mân droseddwr yn system cyfiawnder troseddol ac yn rhoi dewis amgen iddynt yn lle erlyniad troseddol. Y dewis amgen yw rhaglen 4 mis sy'n nodi ac yn delio a'r rhesymau dros yr ymddygiad troseddol. Os nad yw'r troseddwr yn cwblhau'r rhaglen, neu os yw'n methu bodloni'r gofynion, bydd yn dychwelyd i'r system cyfiawnder troseddol ac yn wynebu erlyniad.</p> <p>Mae'r rhaglen amlasiantaeth sy'n gwella ymwybyddiaeth a mynediad unigolion yn y ddalfa i wasanaethau iechyd ar gyfer pawb sy'n cyflwyno yn Nalfa'r Heddlu neu drwy Bresenoldeb Gwirfoddol gyda'r nod o wella iechyd y cyhoedd, cyfleoedd bywyd a lles unigolion a chymunedau. Bydd hefyd yn darparu mynediad i wasanaethau sy'n cynnig cefnogaeth ymarfeol. Mae gan y rhaglen potensial i leihau derbyniadau Daweiniau ac Achosion Brys, drwy godi ymwybyddiaeth a mynediad pobl i ddarpariaethau iechyd tra maent yn y ddalfa.</p>	<p>CheckPoint is a voluntary adult offender diversion scheme which operates in the Durham Constabulary area. It targets low level offenders entering the criminal justice system by providing them an alternative to a criminal prosecution. This alternative is a four month programme which identifies and treats the underlying causes of their offending behaviour. If the offender fails to complete or comply with the four month programme they will return to the criminal justice system and face prosecution.</p> <p>CheckPoint is a multi-agency programme which will improve awareness of and access to health based services for all persons presenting at Police Custody or through Voluntary Attendance with an overall aim of improving public health, life chances, and individual and community wellbeing. It will also provide access to services which offer practical support. The programme has the potential to reduce demand on A&E admissions by increasing awareness of, and access to, health based provisions.</p>

Monitrir y gwaith hwn drwy'r Bwrdd Craffu Checkpoint lle gosodir diweddariadau cyflawni ger bron y bwrdd.</p>	<p>Financial: £343,086.50 has been made available from the 2020/21 Crime and Disorder Grant provided by the Police and Crime Commissioner to support this innovative work.</p> <p>Legal: The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 enables the Commissioner to award grants to partners, public organisations or voluntary groups that can support the community safety priorities identified in the Police and Crime Plan.</p> <p>Police and Crime Plan: This area of work will help the Commissioner meet his main statutory duty of delivering an effective and efficient policing service in North Wales. This work will be monitored through the Checkpoint Scrutiny Board where performance updates will be tabled.</p>
