THE RAPE AND SEXUAL SUPPORT CENTRE (RASASC)

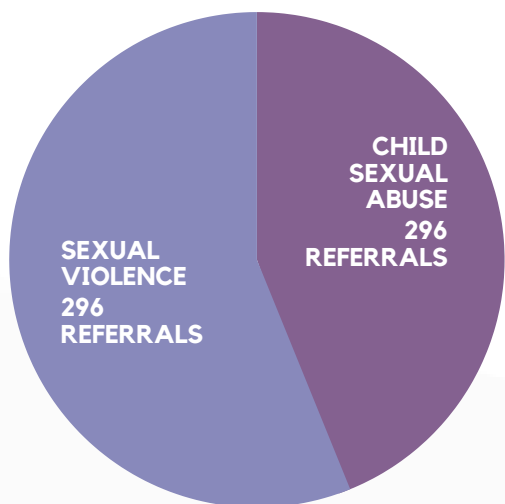

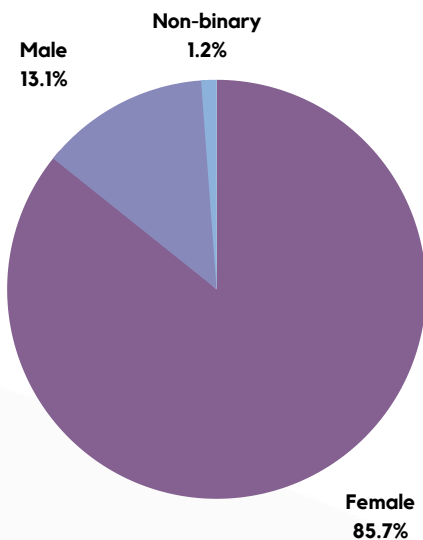

During 20/21 RASASC received a total of **534** new referrals and have supported a total of **675** clients.

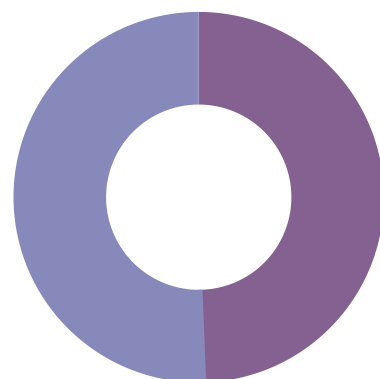
REFERRALS BY CRIME TYPE



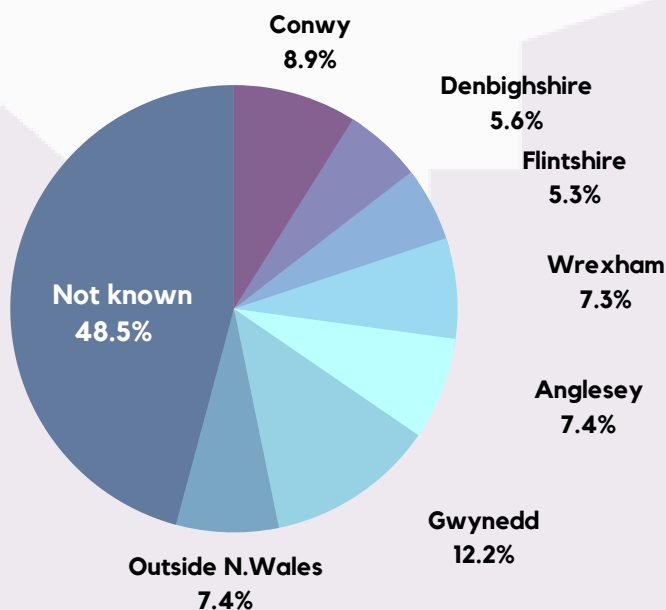
REFERRALS BY GENDER



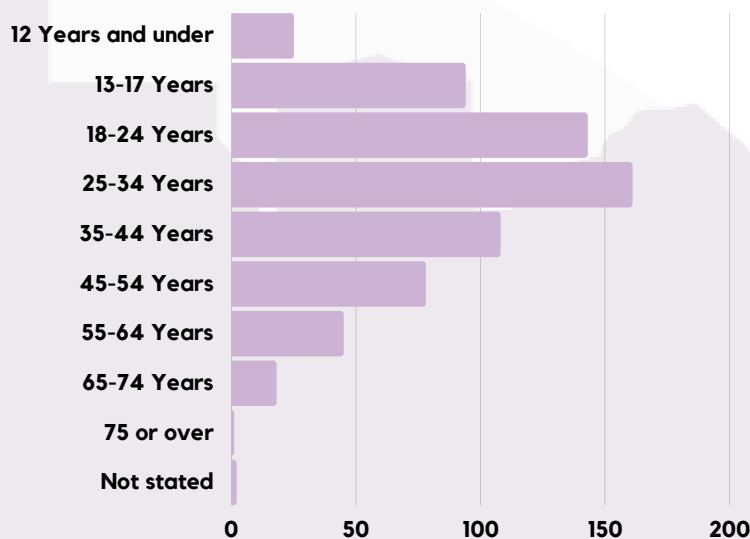
CLIENTS REPORTING THAT THEY ARE BETTER ABLE TO COPE WITH EVERYDAY LIFE **49%**

REGIONAL IDVA SERVICE

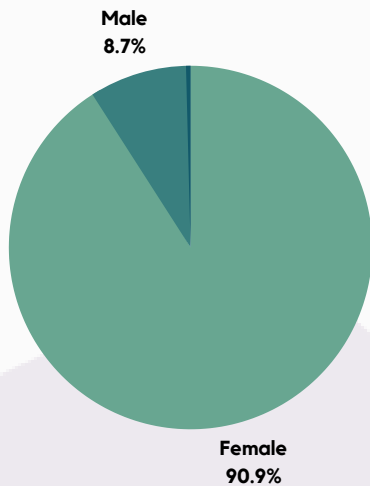

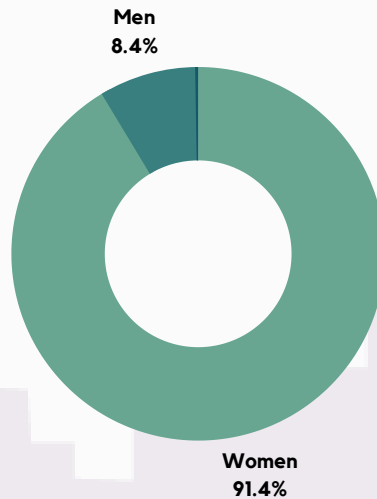

During 20/21 the regional IDVA received a total of **1603** new referrals and have supported a total of **1487** clients.

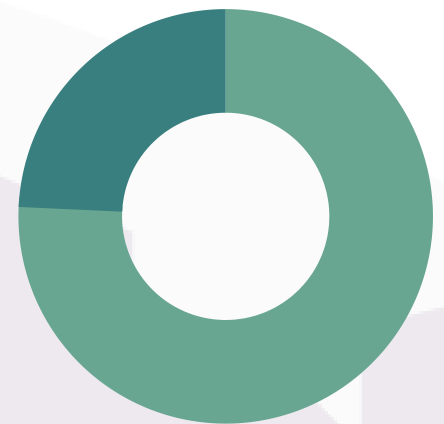
REFERRALS BY GENDER



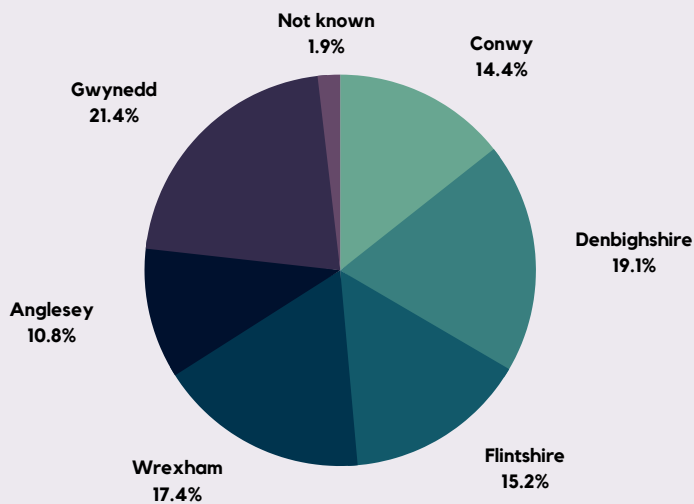

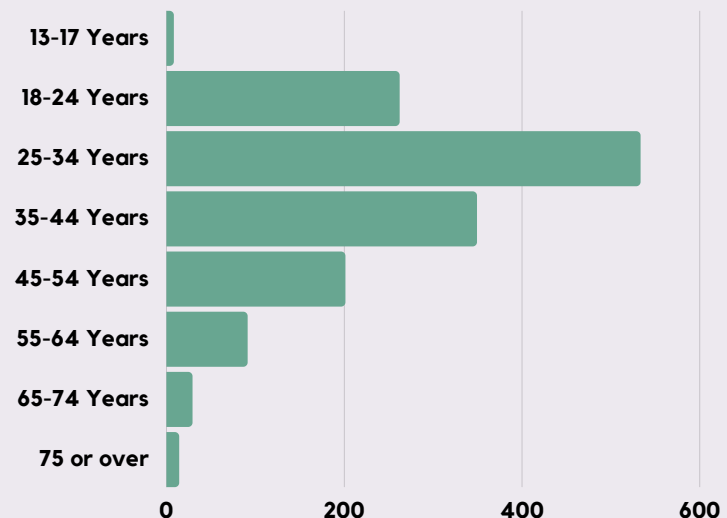
CLIENTS REPORTING THAT THEY ARE BETTER ABLE TO COPE WITH EVERYDAY LIFE

SEXUAL ASSAULT & RAPE CENTRE

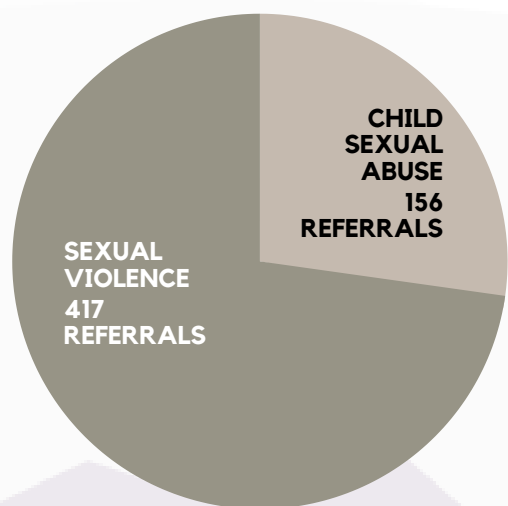

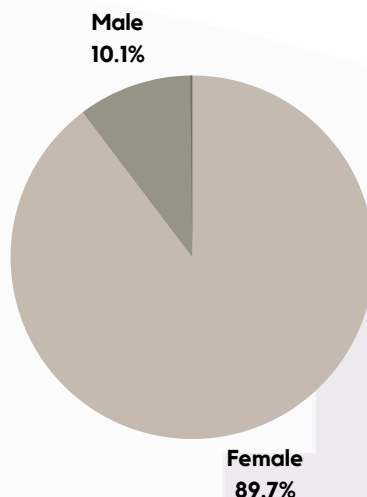

REFERRALS BY CRIME TYPE

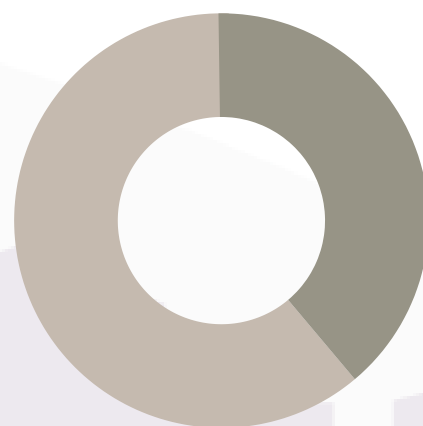


REFERRALS BY GENDER

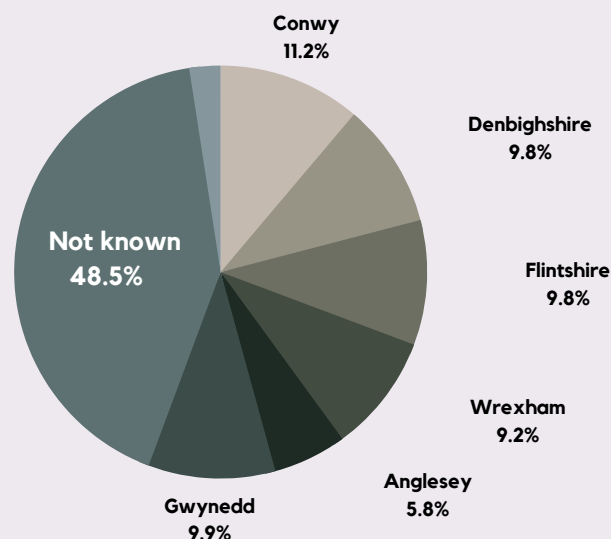

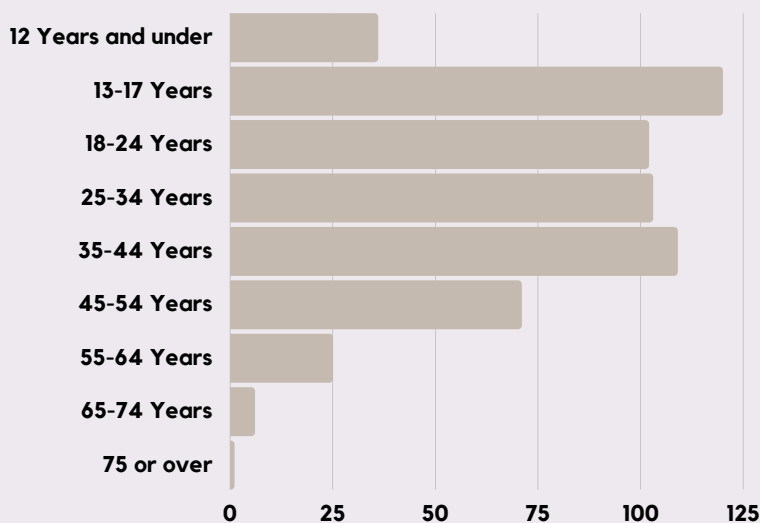

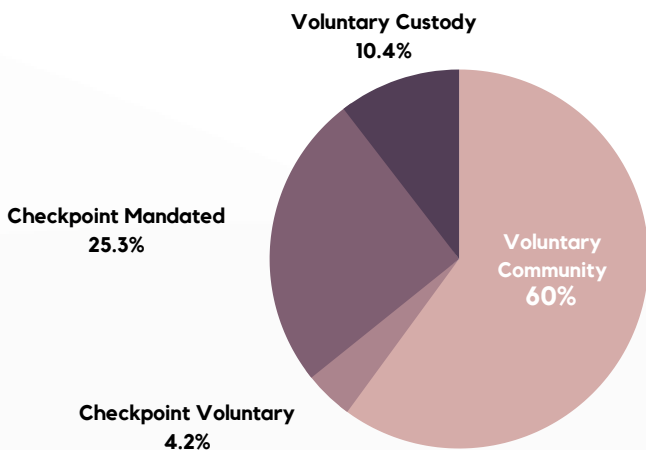

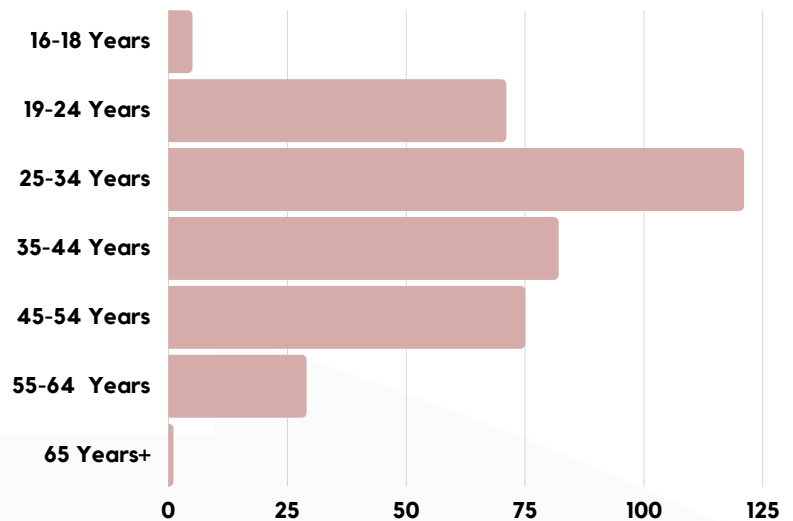

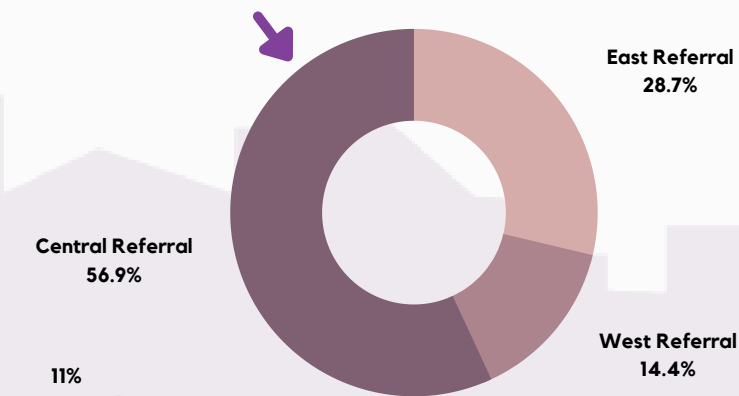
TYPE OF REFERRAL



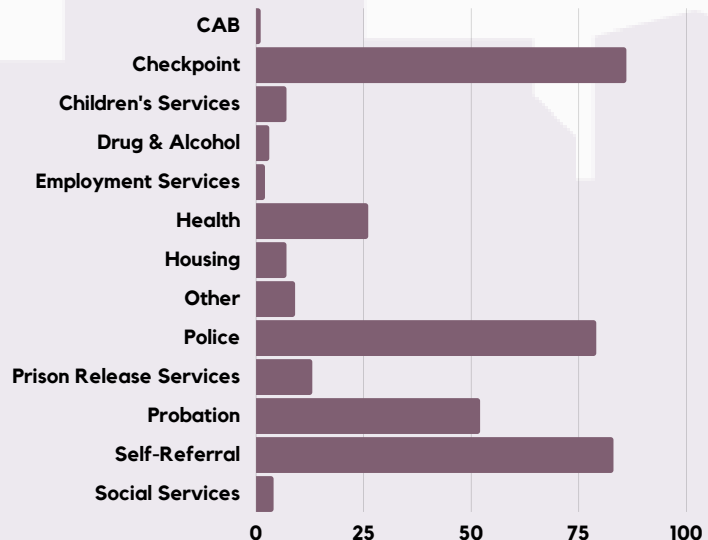
REFERRALS BY AGE



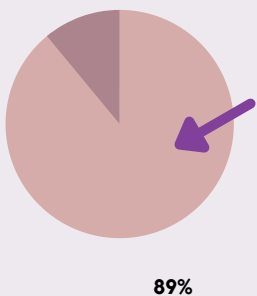
REFERRAL BY AREA

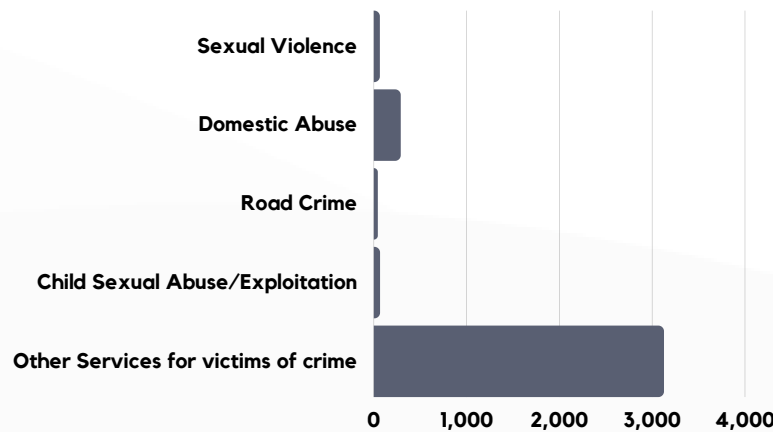

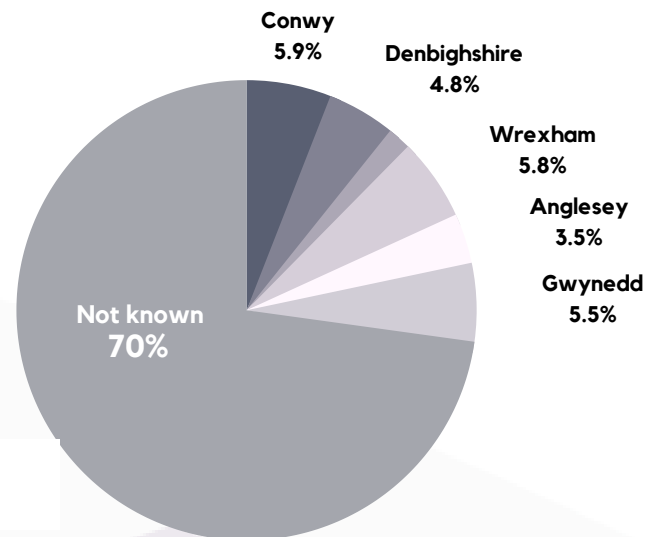
During 20/21 the VHC received a total of **20,380** new referrals

and have supported a total of **15,834** clients and **3,542** victims engaged in two-way support.

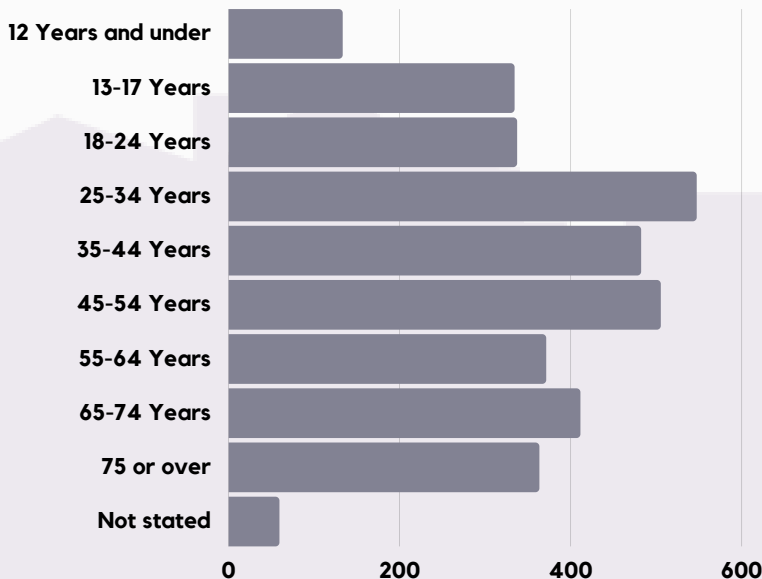
REFERRALS BY CRIME TYPE



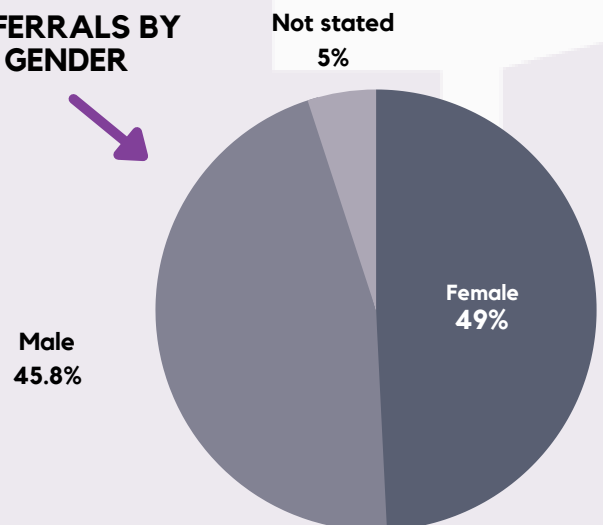
REFERRALS BY COUNTY

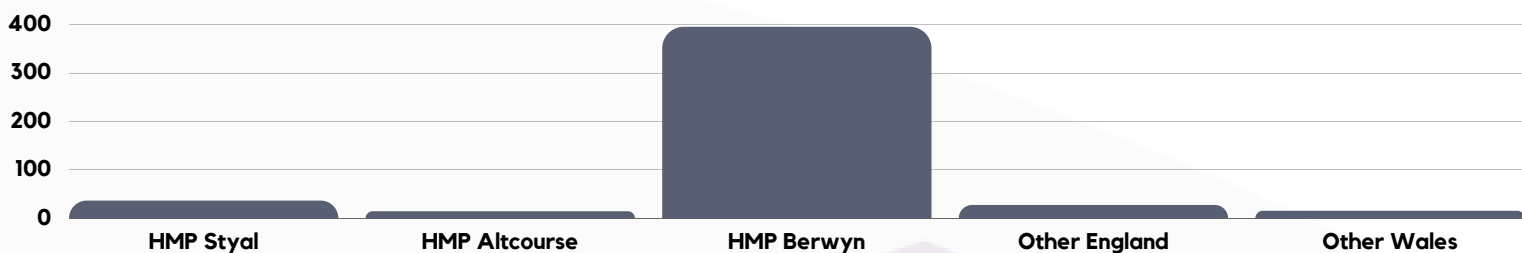
DECHRAU NEWYDD

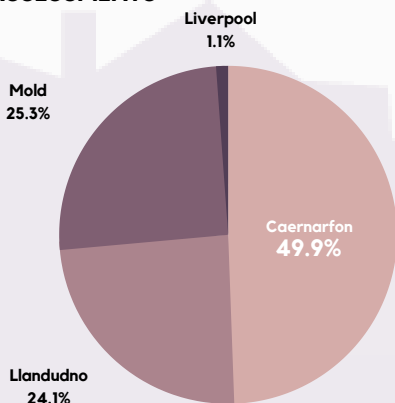

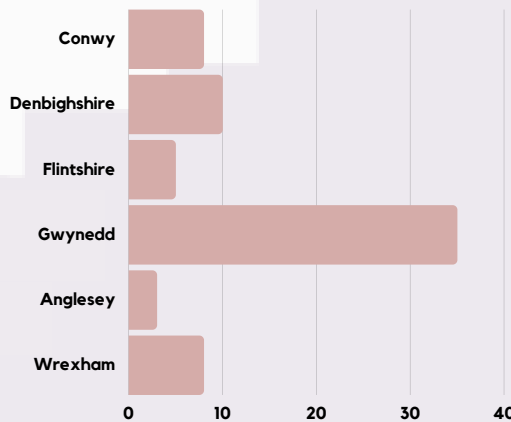

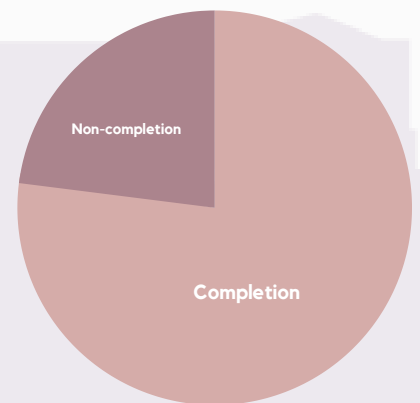
DRUG REHABILITATION REQUIREMENT (DRR) ASSESSMENTS



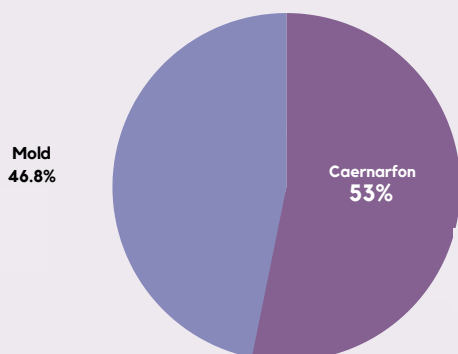
COMMENCEMENT OF DRR BY AREA



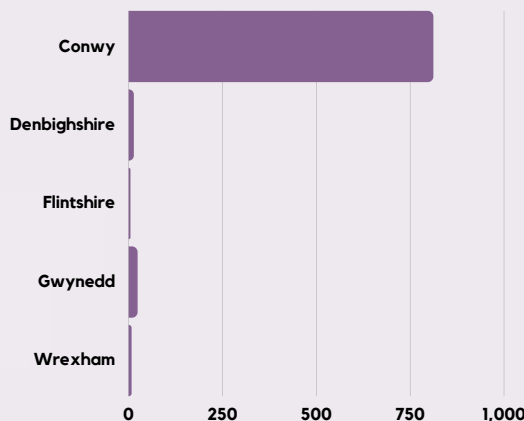
SUCCESSFUL DRR COMPLETION
